FAMILY UPDATE



UPDATE ON AARON – We shared before about our son-in-law Aaron's Arteriovenous Malformation, that he had last December and wanted to give you an update on his condition. We were able to be with Rida and Aaron in February for his second operation where they replaced his skull. The operation was a success. He has made good progress, but he still has a ways to go. Here is part of the most current update that Rida gave on Aaron.

“Good news is, we’re still here! In the last 3 weeks, several things have gone on and yet Aaron’s progress remains basically the same. He is still progressing, becoming more and more understandable as time passes. He is doing really well with his recovery. He is now finished with both occupational therapy and physical therapy. They said that his balance is just about back to normal and the issues he does have with his balance is attributed to his lack of vision on the right.

The only discouraging part about his recovery at this point is that his vision still hasn’t improved enough to give the doctors hope that it will recover. But we know a BIG God who can heal his vision in an instant if he chose to, so I know that if Aaron’s vision does not go back to normal, there’s a specific reason for that. We have also heard stories of people who go through a traumatic brain injury with vision issues who fully recover their vision years after the doctors say they will.”

Please continue to pray for Aaron during this time of recovery.

Pray for Rida and Aaron for their future. He is undergoing a medical review to determine if he will be medically discharged. If so, then they will need to make many decisions concerning their future.
